



JUMPSTART ASSESSMENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA GREEN BUILDING ALLIANCE GREEN BUILDING PRODUCTS INITIATIVE

The following criteria will be used by the Green Building Alliance (GBA) to determine a company's eligibility to participate in the *JumpStart Assessment* program operated through its Green Building Products Initiative.

1. Applicant firms must be for-profit; non-profit and trade organizations are ineligible for this program.
2. Applicant firms must manufacture or distribute products used in the construction of a commercial or residential building, including the surrounding site, as applicable to the Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED®) rating system.

OR

- Applicant firms must intend to manufacture or distribute such a product or service within one year of the completion of a JumpStart Assessment.
3. Applicant firms must be headquartered in Pennsylvania or have a manufacturing or distribution facility located in Pennsylvania.
 4. Funds are limited. Companies with fewer than 500 employees will be given preference.
